# **CHAPTER I**

### INTRODUCTION

## A. Research Background

English is the language of international communication, the language of science knowledge, modern technology, trade, politics, and used almost in all fields, then English becomes the priority for studying foreign languages. Learning English is needed as a medium to communicate with one another (Sharifian, 2009). The purpose and scope of learning English are designed so that students have the following abilities: Develop spoken and written language communication skills. These skills include listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Understand the nature and importance of English to improve the country's competitiveness in a global society. Understand the relationship between language and culture and broaden cultural horizons. In learning English, a teacher needs a strategy to increase students' learning motivation, therefore teachers' strategy is very important in learning activities to achieve the learning objective.

The teachers' strategy is very important because it can facilitate the learning process to get maximum results. The teachers' strategy is related to the teaching and learning process, and the teacher needs a teaching strategy to support the realization of the learning process. A teaching strategy is a generalized plan for a lesson or a lesson that includes structure, desire learner behavior, in terms of the goals of instruction, and an outline of tactics necessary to implement the strategy (Antoni, 2010). Motivation can be interpreted as an urge in a person to do something to achieve certain goals. Purnama et al., (2019) explain the term motivation comes from the Latin word, movere (to move), and then absorbed in the English language into motivation which means providing motivation or cause of motivating that led to encouragement. Learning motivation is a psychological condition that encourages a person to learn, (Khodijah, 2014). learning motivation is the encouragement and needs in learning, the expectations, environment, and activities in learning that are effective and conducive, to enable students to learn well. Therefore, the teacher's role as a motivator is needed in increasing students' English learning motivation during the era of new normal.

In the era of new normal, the government has taken various ways so that education can continue to run because education is a very important asset for a nation for the progress of a country. Habibi (2020), stated that the New Normal is a new life where all people continue to carry out their activities as usual but still apply the health protocols that have been set by the government so that the spread of the Covid-19 virus can be overcome.

Based on pre-observations and interviews conducted by researchers, at SMP Negeri 4 Sajingan Besar teaching and learning activities are carried out by face-to-face learning and complying with health protocols.

Based on the explanation above, the teachers' strategy is very important to increase students' English learning motivation, especially during the era of new normal which is still happening today. # a. Teachers' Strategy
