# CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

# A. Research Background

English is a foreign language used by people in the world to communicate, express, and also express ideas and innovations. Having the ability to speak English also helps people especially in Indonesia to study and work with a better income (Paskalia, 2019; Widy, 2011). If someone has strong English skills, they were able to interact effectively with the global community and build wider relations with others countries.

English is a language that has been studied in elementary school. It has even become a compulsory subject in certain schools. The use of foreign languages, especially English, would be better if introduced early (early school age) (Putranti *et al.*, 2019). In fact, there are still students who do not feel safe and comfortable when learning English. Music illustration media can change the learning environment to be fun so that students are enthusiastic to learn (Roffiq *et al.*, 2017). Using traditional songs in teaching English builds a pleasant atmosphere that makes students more interested in learning English.

The traditional song used contains a song that they generally hear. So, students are familiar with the song. In traditional songs, there are social objectives, text structure, and linguistic characteristics contained in them which they solve whatever it is. Therefore, students can find out the meaning of the traditional song. When students are faced with a problem, they become motivated in learning. Students who can think creatively have high intrinsic motivation in learning and have a strong drive, confidence, and high thinking skills (Pentury, 2017). In Sungai Deras English Village itself has not implemented traditional song translation lessons. Therefore, the researcher uses a case study in learning English. The researcher not only investigated the situation in Sungai Deras English Village but also taught students to use traditional song translation with a genre-based approach.

Innovations in learning are needed in the teaching and learning process of English. In order to facilitate this need, the local authority of Sungai Deras Village, Kubu Raya collaborated with IKIP-PGRI Pontianak held Sungai Deras English Village. In this research, the researcher in English Village used media in the form of traditional song which is translated into English.

In order to realize the need for English, researchers from IKIP-PGRI Pontianak collaborated with the management and residents of Sungai Deras Village to organize Sungai Deras English Village. In the world of education, an approach is needed to increase students' motivation in learning English. Therefore, a new method is needed, one of which is using songs in learning English. Utilizing songs in classroom can relax students' mind and body and can make them listening more enjoyable (Putri, 2018). Then, using songs can help learners improve their listening skills and pronunciation; they can also be useful for teaching vocabulary and sentence structure (Millington, 2011). Morevover, the advantage of song in learning English is that is it can increase student motivation and can enrich students vocabulary (Mahardika et al., 2020). Therefore, to motivate children to learn is singing so that children know vocabulary which method of singing is very appropriate considering the age of children is the age of playing while playing they sing (Maulina et al., 2020). In this case, the researchers used traditional songs as teaching materials to be taught in Sungai Deras English Village. Traditional songs usually refer to songs that have a specific rhythm for a region (Renyaan et al., 2020).

In particular, previous research has focused on the use of songs in learning English in formal schools. Therefore, the researcher applies the use of traditional song translations in the context of no-formal education which in Kampung Inggris Sungai Deras has also never applied the use of traditional song translations in learning English.

Based on previous relevant research, English Village Sungai Deras Kubu Raya requires learning with new material innovations. Therefore, researchers are interested in researching the use of learning materials that can attract students to teaching English, entitled "USING TRANSLATED"

### E. Scope of the Research

## 2. Research Terminology

### a. Translated Traditional Song
